Verbal Behavior Programming

Participants will learn Skinner's *Verbal Operants*, specific teaching protocols, and data collection procedures. Participants will receive video modeling of how instructional methods are ran and allowed opportunities to practice and get feedback. They will be tested out on these particular protocols and procedures. Although it is designed to meet the unique needs of students with Autism Spectrum Disorders (ASD), it is also beneficial for students with other developmental delays, who need a more specialized program.

Participants will learn:

- How motivating operations and reinforcement impact learning outcomes
- Effective school-based programming using the VB-MAPP
- Errorless and error correction procedures
- How to make data-based decisions using a cold probe data collection procedure
- How to schedule instruction and organize materials
